

Tech Brief: Making Backups of Sybase databases

Without a special backup “agent” that backs up open Sybase databases, you must perform a database unload to back up the database. The following script can be used to perform this action. You can place this into a batch file and then use NT or Win98 Scheduler to schedule the batch file as needed.

c:

```
cd \hfw13sql\database
```

```
dbbackup -y -c "autostop=yes;start=c:\sqlany50\win32\dbclient sqlany;agent=client;eng=sqlany;dbn=sathfwpr;uid=dba;pwd=sql" c:\hfw14sql\database\backup
```
